Length 0.6m, lightweight 7kg (excluding battery), no assembly required. Can be carried and used by one person.

It starts up in just one minute, so you can get work done in less time. With its user-friendly "intuitive operation," it can take over the task of "seeing" and "taking pictures" in any water area. It can be operated remotely from a safe location, improving the safety of people working in water areas.

At the booth, we will also have a demonstration video available, showing the smallest USV with camera "Swimmy Eye" navigating the water's surface, as well as camera footage from the camera attached to the "Swimmy Eye".

Homura Heavy Industries is actively developing various solutions and water surface drones for challenging fields such as coast guard operations, water rescue, water quality and marine surveys, bathymetry, seabed topography, seaweed bed surveys, water infrastructure inspections, box culvert inspections, water surface cleaning (garbage and oil collection), waterborne logistics,
